

ANALYZING MAPS ANSWERS

1. Location The Everglades; Lake Okeechobee
2. Movement From 1740 to 1822, the Seminole lived in northeast Florida. From 1822 to 1842, they lived in central and southern Florida.
3. Location Fowltown in 1817 and Suwannee in 1818.
4. Region The Seminole Reservation overlapped with some of the territory the Seminole had occupied from 1822 to 1842.
5. Elaborate Possible response: The swamps probably made it much more difficult for the U.S. forces to move through Florida and pursue the Seminole. Certain Seminole could have adopted white culture to avoid relocating.
