## ANALYZING MAPS ANSWERS

- 1. Location The Everglades; Lake Okeechobee
- 2. Movement From 1740 to 1822, the Seminole lived in northeast Florida. From 1822 to 1842, they lived in central and southern Florida.
- 3. Location Fowltown in 1817 and Suwannee in 1818.
- 4. Region The Seminole Reservation overlapped with some of the territory the Seminole had occupied from 1822 to 1842.
- 5. Elaborate Possible response: The swamps probably made it much more difficult for the U.S. forces to move through Florida and pursue the Seminole. Certain Seminole could have adopted white culture to avoid relocating.
