
The Seminole Wars

Between 1817 and 1842, the United States fought two wars with the Seminole Indians of Florida. By the end of these wars, most of the Seminole had been removed to Indian Territory in what is now the state of Oklahoma. The map below shows the locations of the Seminole in Florida from 1740 to 1842 as well as the sites of major battles during the Seminole Wars. Study the map.
