

1. Pop sov: Let the people choose.
2. Uncle Tom's Cabin: Anti-Slavery novel by Harriet Beecher Stowe
3. Secede: To leave or break away from
4. Comp. of 1850: Written by Clay, allowed California into Union as a free state
5. Sectionalism: caring only about your areas needs and not the nation's needs
6. Free-Soil Party: new political party that didn't want slavery in the new territories
7. Fugitive Slave Act: Part of Comp of 1850, if you helped a runaway slave you could have to pay \$1000 and spend 6 months in jail
